# **CIRCULAR**

# SUB: STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES FOR NATIONAL COACHING CAMPS & NCOEs

In supersession of earlier SOPs issued vide circular No. 858/SAI/OPS/NCOE/SOP/2020-21 dated 7<sup>th</sup> April, 2021, please find enclosed revised SOPs that have to be strictly adhered to, to contain spread of COVID-19.

- 2. Further, RDs/NCOE Heads will exercise their discretion to decide whether RTPCR or RAT test is to be done for testing of athletes on arrival at the Centre.
- 3. Further, in case situation warrants, RDs/NCOE Heads may take more precautions/strict measures to contain the spread of Covid-19 in their RCs/NCOEs as well as for smooth conduct of sports activities.
- 4. The guidelines issued by State Govt. shall supersede these SOPs.


# **COVID STANDARED OPERATING PROCEDURES FOR NATIONAL CAMPS & NCOES**

## 1. ON ARRIVAL TO TRAINING CENTRE

- a) All athletes will undergo thermal checking on arrival.
- b) All athletes will undergo mandatory RAT on arrival.
  - If negative Training be allowed.
  - If positive- Isolation & Treatment (Confirmation by RTPCR).
- c) All athletes will submit a self-declaration form for-
  - Vaccination status
  - Travel history
  - History of exposure to COVID positive case.
- d) All athletes will submit Consent form for-
- Training
- · Participation in competitions,
- Associated COVID risk
- To maintain all COVID 19 safety protocols
- e) Isolation facility must be earmarked for Covid positive/symptomatic athletes.
- f) Separate staff should be deputed for Isolation zone and use of PPE kit is recommended.
- g) Appropriate system to be put in place for Biomedical waste generated during quarantine.
- h) Sanitization of the area twice a day is mandatory.

#### 2. RTPCR test

-If any athlete is symptomatic -RTPCR



3. Athlete returning from competitions- same testing rules will apply as mentioned on arrival.

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4. Athlete returning from leave- Mandatory RAT test as above.

#### 5. Training areas

- a) Athlete allowed in training area after thermal screening.
- b) Sanitization of equipment used is mandatory.(Once after every use)
- c) Athletes and all support staff must follow covid responsible behavior at all times.
- d) Sanitization facilities /Hand washing facilities must be available near FOP/Training area.

#### 6. Precautions in premises

- a) Mess Follow Covid appropriate behavior, Queue management, removal of mask only while eating. No food from outside shall be allowed.
- b) Hostels -Follow Covid appropriate behavior, Hand sanitizers at doors/gates. Sanitization of parcel at entry point.

# 7. Hygiene Officer

- a) One hygiene officer to be nominated for the national camp by RD to supervise the implementation of COVID 19 protocols.
- b) One hygiene officer to be nominated for NCOE by RD/NCOE In charge to supervise the implementation of COVID 19 protocols.

# **Role Of Hygiene Officer**

- -Monitoring &helping in implementation of COVID-19 protocols.
- Should be member of support staff.
- -Should understand and report COVID symptoms immediately to medical officer and Center Incharge.
- -Should record temperature before entering the FOP prior to every training session.
- -Temperature recording -submitted once daily.

# 8. Competitions

- a) Those recommended by respective NSF and TOPS /TEAMS by HO be allowed.
- b) Invitational tournaments and NON-qualifying events for major competitions, RDs may decide.

#### 9. Reporting of Symptoms:

- a) Self reporting by athletes even with minor cold and cough to the hygiene officer who shall report to medical officer & Center Incharge.
- b) They should avoid visiting medical centre instead they should seek help over phone first.

# 10. Medical consultations -

- a) Medical consultation with doctor at the centre.
- b) Outside consultation and visits -To be decided by RDs as per doctors advise on case to case basis.

#### 11. Leave for campers/NCOEs athletes-

a) Leave should not be granted except in emergency.

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# 12. Violation of COVID Appropriate behaviors-

- a. Warning letters should be issued immediately for not following COVID appropriate behavior.
- <u>b.</u> On repeated violations, even after warning, strict action including removal from Camp/NCOE shall be considered.

# 13. Scientific & Medical staff & Coaches -residing outside the premises & involved in training of athletes-

- a. Persons who are completely vaccinated shall be allowed to enter after thermal screening.
- b. For incomplete/non vaccinated, it is mandatory for them to complete vaccination.
- c. Mandatory PPE kit to be worn when in close contact with athletes while testing.
- d. Support & Coaching staff coming from outside must inform the center in charge if anyone experiences COVID symptoms.
- 14. Family members residing in campus must inform the center in charge if anyone experiences COVID symptoms.
- 15. Visitors who are completely vaccinated shall be allowed to enter the premises after thermal screening .
- 16. Daily routine monitoring varies from center to center based on location, additional measures if required, the respective RDs may issue guidelines.
