The 58th Meeting of the GB of SAI was held in hybrid (video conference as well as physical attendance) mode on 19.09.2023 at 06.30 PM under the Chairmanship of Shri Anurag Singh Thakur. Hon ble Minister for Youth Affairs & Sports (MYA&S) at Conference Room, SAI HO, New Delhi.

Agenda Item No. 1 Welcome new Members of Governing Body and Presentation on SAI

The Member Secretary, GB and Secretary SAI welcomed all new Members of newly reconstituted GB and also apprised all regarding the activities of SAI through a presentation.

The ATR on the decisions taken in the 57<sup>th</sup> Governing Body meeting was discussed. While discussing Item No. 9, the Hon'ble Chairman, GB desired to have a separate meeting to ascertain the need to lay Mondo Track at the NS NIS Patiala.

Hon'ble Chairman, GB was briefed that the MPEd. courses will be more job orientated. Shri Piyush Jain, Secretary, Physical Education Foundation of India (PEFI) also explained the importance of this Course and how it is different from any specialized sports and coaching courses.

However, Hon'ble Chairman, GB desired to be presented with the statistical analysis on the employment opportunities after completion of the Course before coming to any decision.

Any deviation from Scope of Work will invariably be put up to the Head Office for approval.

Any Other Matter - Secretary (Sports) raised the issue of the request of the National Anti Doping Agency (NADA) under consideration with the Ministry for waiver off monthly licence fee as well as the outstanding licence fee liability of Rs 21.49 crore payable by the NADA in favour of the SAI for the allotted office space to NADA in Hall No. 103 & 104 at JLN Stadium, in line with the direction of the Chairman, GB at the GB NADA meeting held on 14.07.2023.

Secretary (Sports) stated that NADA is fully funded by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports by means of grant and has no other source for revenue generation. Therefore, it is not possible for them to release the payment of the outstanding liability of Rs 21.49 crore vis-à-vis the overall allotted budget resource of Rs 21.73 crore, unless grant is made available through budget.

Secretary (Sports) further stated that since both SAI and NADA function under the Department of Sports, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, GB may consider a waiver off the monthly licence fee as well as that of the outstanding licence fee liability in respect of the office space for NADA in the JLN Stadium.

The GB approved the proposal for rent-free office space for the NADA in JLN Stadium and for the waiver off the outstanding licence fee payable by the NADA to SAI.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
