Minutes of the Departmental Project Approval Committee ("DPAC") Meeting Held on 12.10.2020

A Meeting of Departmental Project Approval Committee (DPAC) of the Khelo India Scheme was conducted on 12.10.2020 at 03:00 PM via Video Conference under the chairmanship of Secretary (Sports).

The list of members who attended the meeting is enclosed at **Annexure-I**

Following Decisions were taken:-

<u>Agenda Item No. 1</u>: Hiring of Digital Media, Branding and Communication Agency

The Committee decided that the proposal needs to be reviewed and placed before DPAC in next meeting.

<u>Agenda Item No.2:</u> Adoption of State/UT's centres to Khelo India State Centre of Excellence

The committee noted that proposals from 27 States / UT's have been received so far, out of which 08 KISCE's have been notified vide DPAC meeting dated 04.06.2020 and 06 KISCE's vide meeting dated 04.09.2020.

DPAC decided to designate the best training centre of the state in terms of training facilities in priority sports disciplines (mentioned below), infrastructure facilities & champions produced by the training centre. Accordingly, following 09 Centres of States/UT's out of the remaining 13 proposals received are designated as *Khelo India State Centre of Excellence*:
