1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted if OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meet prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
2. If the bidder is a Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Exemption from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any other criteria for evaluation by the buyer.
3. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover or average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account.
4. OEM Turn Over Criteria: The minimum average annual financial turnover of the OEM of the offered product during the last three years in form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant. If OEM is less than 3 year old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account.
5. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore): Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as per MII order issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to participate. In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the MII order, the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of MII order. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product.
7. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be a criterion for reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.
8. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar products to Government Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity of primary product category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.
